

Worland Contractor's Board
September 10, 2015

The Worland Contractor's Board met in regular session at Worland City Hall at 5:03 p.m. Board members in attendance were Chairman Mike Montoya, Mark Decker, Josh Craft, Jeremy Carver and Jason Mocko (arrived at 5:15 pm). Also in attendance was Advisor Ron Vanderpool, Laure Mitchell & Building Official Nick Kruger. Member Joe Sterling was absent. Chairman Mike Montoya brought the meeting to order and asked for a motion to approve the August 27, 2015 minutes.

Under Old Business, the Contractor License requirement changes are also still being considered and will go forward as time goes on stated Advisor Vanderpool.

Advisor Ron Vanderpool presented a rundown of the 2015 International Code Council Changes from an online brochure received from the ICC. Videos are available for the changes and we will be reviewing some of these in our upcoming meetings.

Chairman Mike Montoya reminded the members that a vacancy in the Board has come up and we need to fill it. As a member of the Board each member automatically receives 6 hours of training for the year. Don Vail expressed an interest in joining the Board and was asked to submit a letter to present to the Board to vote on at the next meeting. Each visitor to the ICC Changes meeting will receive one hour credit for each meeting attended.

Under Business of Members Jeremy Carver questioned a change in curb stop policies. Advisor Vanderpool explained that the policies were already in place but had not been enforced until a recent incident exasperated the situation and resulted in the City being more stringent on enforcing the policies.

Advisor Vanderpool reminded the Board that 3 hours are given to any contractor that joins the International Code Council to help fulfill the 6 hour continuous education requirement for the year.
