

Worland Contractor's Board

Under Old Business Advisor Ron Vanderpool suggested the Board wait on the Mechanical Code changes and spend the meeting going over the information Building Inspector Nick Kruger has put together regarding Contractor Licensing.

Building Inspector Kruger went over a matrix that he had put together to get input from the Board. Discussion followed as he went over each designation. It was stressed by the Board that Supervisory experience was an important element to be included in the years of experience. It was recommended that Exterior Finish Demolition, Interior Finish, Painting and Insulation be combined into the Handyman designation by members Joe Sterling and Mike Montoya.

A new designation of Manufactured Building Installer was presented and discussed. There was a consensus of opinion by the Board that a possible probation period be introduced with a three job minimum. The option of getting rid of the Apprentice charge of ten dollars was considered.

The next Board of Contractors meeting will be December 10, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. The meeting was adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
