City of Worland Worland Municipal Airport Notice of Proposed Passenger Facility Charge Project

The City of Worland, Wyoming, owner and operator of the Worland Municipal Airport intends to file an application with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to impose and use passenger facility charges (PFCs) for projects associated with the Worland Municipal Airport. As required under Section 158.23 of the Federal Aviation Regulations FAR Part 158 Passenger Facility Charges, the City is hereby providing written notice to the general public, and all air carriers operating at the Worland Municipal Airport. FAR Part 158 is the final rule by the FAA that implements sections 9110 and 9111 of the Aviation Safety and Capacity Act of 1990, passed by the U.S. Congress in November 1990.

Description of the project being considered for funding by PFCs for the Worland Municipal Airport is the reimbursement to the Airport of local share funds expended on 5 AIP projects at the Worland Municipal Airport from 2004 until present day. PFC funds required to cover those local share fund costs total \$193,038.02, and are estimated to be recoverable over approximately 14 years.

A meeting will be held on Thursday, April 3rd, 2008 at 3:00 PM., in the airport conference room, Main Terminal Building, Worland Municipal Airport, Worland, Wyoming, to discuss the details of this project.
